Halton Hills honours leadership in green development

Halton Hills council handed out its inaugural Excellence in Green Development Leadership Awards during its regular meeting earlier this month.

The Green Development Leadership Awards were established to recognize and celebrate developments that comply with or exceed the minimum point requirements of the Town's Green Development Standards, said the municipality in a release.

In 2014, Halton Hills established point-based criteria in an effort to promote green development within town limits.

The Town's standards are designed to maximize the positive attributes while minimizing potentially negative impacts of development, added the release.

The awards fall under two categories the Award of Achievement and the Award of Excellence. All recipients are recommended by the Town's Green Development Leadership Awards judging panel and confirmed by council.

Awards of Achievement recipients must meet the minimum number of points required by the

town's Green Development Standards, while Awards of Excellence winners must incorporate innovative approaches to green development and exceed the required number of points by at least 20 per cent. The latter must also verify their compliance with the town's standards through a third-party.
