Saxton, who served as MP for North Vancouver from 2008-15, was an executive in financial sector working for two of the world's largest firms before moving to the public sector in the legislature. He is currently CEO of a real estate investment firm, and like O Leary and Peterson believes his experience in the business world gives him an inside track on getting Canada's economy rolling.

O Toole, currently MP in the riding of Durham, also spoke at length about the economy and called for big changes to avoid what he described as a bleak economic future. He also called for more investment in the military and spoke about the importance of not letting opponents of conservatism define them as a party.

Both Raitt and Chong played to their home-field advantage a bit and scored points with local references, while leveraging their established local popularity effectively. Both are long-serving members of parliament in their respective Halton ridings.

Chong spent a good chunk of his

speech sharing his family story and then stuck mostly to bedrock conservative principles. He was also the loudest advocate for environmental protection and sustainability among his peers.

Raitt, who started out by sharing the story of her journey from the Maritimes to Ontario and the career of her dreams, spent most of her time talking about how to beat Trudeau in the next election. She emphasized learning the lessons from past experiences of losing to Trudeau. She offered some areas of focus she believes are essential in the task and how her experience has prepared her for the challenge.

Breaking from the rest of the herd a bit, Alexander who represented the riding of Ajax-Pickering from 2011-15 took a more global focus in his speech. While not venturing too far from his conservative roots, he focused on international trade and global markets more than any other. He also emphasized growing Canada's energy and technology sectors.

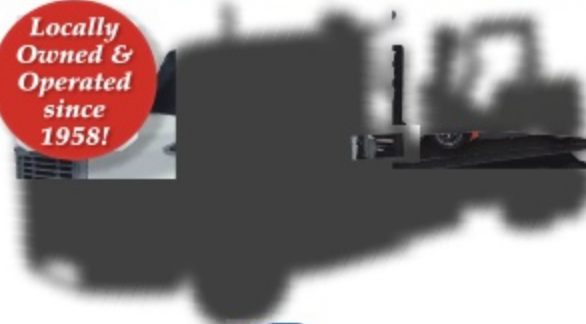
