However, at the end of January, Switzer said she talked to BIA board members and was able to pull together a proposal to have a market running in 2017.

We wanted to regroup and look at how we can redefine the market, give it a new identity, Switzer said.

Although it hasn t been approved as of yet, Switzer is hoping members are on board.

Tremblay said the move left her feeling cheated.

I already did all the footwork, Tremblay said. I ve already got approval from the health department, and I ve already got approval for the location.

Switzer said the BIA was clear in its intentions of reviving the market when last season wrapped up.

It was pretty clear last year when we said that we wanted to re-evaluate the market, and our intention was to bring it back, she said. Our intention was never to give up the market entirely. We always planned on bringing it back.

Last month, Switzer got in touch with Tremblay and requested the two work together, but Tremblay said she wasn t comfortable with that.

Us working together is more or less just me handing over the vendors, Tremblay said. We re very proud of the fact we ve achieved all of this at this

A farmers market is something the BIA recognizes is very important to our downtown core, Switzer said. It does bring a lot of vitality and life into downtown, which is why I approached Angela and asked her if we could work together to keep it downtown.

Id much rather work together than work against each other.

Tremblay has not been paid for the work involved in starting up the Farmers Market on 7. All she wants is a place for the community to peruse local goods.

Tremblay explained this market will offer vendors the opportunity to grow.

This is a vendor's market. It is not with the BIA at all, she said. We will listen to the people of Acton and give them what they want because that s our priority: to make the people of Acton happier.

Tremblay is hopeful she can carry the market through until Christmas indoors, but those plans haven t been secured yet.
