## OJHL East Division presides over the path to RBC Cup

The road to the national Jr. A championship goes through Ontario this year as Trenton hosts the Dudley Hewitt Cup central Canada tournament in early May, followed by the five-team Royal Bank Cup held later that month nearby Cobourg.

The OJHL's East Division is by far the most competitive in the league with all five teams finishing well above the .500 mark, yet the Georgetown Raiders posted a 3-1-1 against those teams all road games.

Georgetown's lone appearance in the RBC came in 2005 after it played host to the Dudley Hewitt Cup and defeated current Anaheim Duck Andrew Cogliano and the St. Michael's Buzzers 3-0 in the final.

An undisciplined Raider side went 2-2 in the round-robin segment of the RBC tournament in Weyburn, Sask. before getting mauled 8-2 in the semifinals by the Camrose (Alta.) Kodiaks.

**FRIENDLY FIRE:** OJHL teams can call up affiliated players once their teams are eliminated from the post-season, so head

coach & GM Greg Walters has several veteran Jr. B options to choose from, meaning that some Raiders who've been here since August might be watching from the stands.

You're playing for ice time in the playoffs, Walters added.

The guys who are maybe a little lower down on the depth chart or guys we brought in later have to realize they're playing for a spot in the lineup.

Ryan Miotto, a 17-year-old affiliate player from the Welland Jr. Canadians of the Golden Horseshoe Jr. B league, scored in each of Georgetown's last two regular-season contests. Fifteen-year-old blueliner Mitch Brewer of the Halton minor midget Hurricanes played three games with the Raiders and didn't look out of place.

Raider fans will recall the impact Florida Panthers second-round draft pick Adam Mascherin had for Georgetown during its 2013-14 run, potting 11 goals in 16 games featuring some remarkable marksmanship for a 15-year-old.
