Halton Hills celebrates Canada 150 year-round

An initiative kick-started in Calgary to celebrate Canada's 150th has made its way into Halton Hills.

The 3 Things for Canada is a program that encourages all residents to do three things for the neighbourhood, the nation, and the world this year. According to a report from the Town of Halton Hills, if everyone in Canada did three good deeds, that would result in over 100 million acts of community building.

Residents are encouraged to share their three things that will impact the community in a positive way.

The three things could be as simple as helping a neighbour or as big as starting a new initiative, Halton Hills councillor and Federation of Community Municipalities president Clark Somerville said. It's the difference we make collectively as a community, the difference that our community makes to Canada, that's what's important.

Mayor Rick Bonnette has come up with his three things. The first is to shovel the fire hydrant from across his home after a heavy snowfall to save the Halton Hills Fire Department from doing it and to make sure his neighbours are safe. The second is to pick up garbage he sees while out for a walk. The third is a promise to donate to local charities to help people in our community.

Residents are asked to share their three things by posting it on haltonhills.ca or on Instagram by using the hashtag #hhCanada150.

Alongside the 3 Things for Canada program, the town has come up with a number of other initiatives to celebrate this milestone birthday.

A cultural assets tour will take place during the summer where a number of self-guided tours will be available at locations in town that offer arts, history and architecture.

Citizenship and citizen reconfirmation ceremonies will also take place during the Glen's Canada Day celebration or at the
