Province honours 42 volunteers from Halton Hills

The Ontario government honoured more than 40 Halton Hills residents for their community service efforts during a ceremony in Mississauga last week.

Part of the province's annual Volunteer Service Awards initiative, the program recognized more than 11,000 volunteers at 55 ceremonies across the province in 2017.

Volunteers from Halton Hills and the surrounding areas were honoured during ceremonies on April 18-19 held at the Mississauga Convention Centre.

Volunteers are recognized for every five years of continuous service with a single organization.

The Ontario Volunteer Service Awards recognize adult volunteers for five to 65-plus years of continuous service to an organization and youth volunteers for two or more years of continuous service, wrote the province in a statement.

Among this year's notable recipients from Halton Hills were George Henderson from Acton, honoured for 45 years of volunteer service to the Acton chapter of Scouts Canada. Rena Arbic, also from Acton, was honoured for 40 years of service to Link2Care, while fellow Acton residents John Hansen and Terry Foster received pins for 25 years of service with the Knox Presbyterian Church and the Acton Agricultural Society, respectively.
