Destroy Nuisance Weeds

Giant Hogweed

Giant Hogweed is a non-native plant from Europe. It is a very dangerous to humans. If you find it on your property, you must report it to the Town of Halton Hills by June 1, 2017.

County of Halton By-law 2008-0438 No. Part 3 Section 8 states that Property Owners are required to destroy or remove any noxious weeds on their property.

Any person who destroys or removes any noxious weeds on their property is liable for the costs of such work.

As a result, the Town of Halton Hills may enter upon your property to carry out the work required.

The Town of Halton Hills may also enter upon your property to carry out the work required to remove any noxious weeds on your property.

Please note that the Town of Halton Hills is **NOT** responsible for the removal of noxious weeds.



Destroy Noxious Weeds

NO ONE IS HEREBY GIVEN to persons in possession of land or tenement land. Control Act R.S.O. 4cc0' .5'. It is the duty of every owner of land in the Town of Halton Hills to destroy by June 1, 2017 any noxious weeds growing on their property. The Town of Halton Hills may enter upon the property of any owner to destroy any noxious weeds on their property. The Town of Halton Hills may also enter upon the property of any owner to destroy any noxious weeds on their property.

The purpose of the Control Act is to protect the public from the harmful effects of noxious weeds on their property.

The Control Act does not apply to noxious weeds on the property of any person who is not a resident of the Town of Halton Hills.
