All about car seat safety education

Members of the OPP also took part in what HPCSS is calling more of a car seat clinic.

The mandate of this is educate first and enforce second, said Snow. Our purpose here is to safeguard the needs of children.

Drivers are legally responsible for the safety of the child and the installation of the car seat, even if the vehicle is borrowed. Charges when caught on the roads can include cash fines, demerit points and court appearances.

According to the Ontario Ministry of Transportation's website, the Highway Traffic Act requires children under 20 pounds to

use a rear-facing car seat. Children weighing 20 to 40 pounds can use a forward-facing child car seat or a rear-facing car seat, as long as it meets manufacturer specifications. Kids under the age of eight standing at less than four foot nine and weighing between 40 to 80 pounds must use a booster seat.

Kids can begin using just a seatbelt once they turn eight years old. Children under eight can do so if they are four foot nine or taller, or when they reach 80 pounds.

but still just a penny in terms A great feat of research funding.

We have seen more research in bladder cancer in the last two years than in the previous 30, he said.

The group s message is first and foremost, a type of support group for patients and caregivers affected by bladder cancer. According to Moon, there are different stages and grades to bladder cancer, much like other cancers, and the group helps people get set up with other people going through a similar circumstance.

According to Moon, 75 per cent of bladder cancer is found in males; the other 25 per cent in females.

When I was diagnosed, I had never heard of bladder cancer, he said. Very few have. It s growing, the knowledge, but it still has a long way to go.

He said in 2017, Canada will have 9,000 people diagnosed with bladder cancer; 80,000 currently live with it.

Our goal, long-term, is to make every Canadian aware of bladder cancer, he said. Bladder cancer is the fifth most diagnosed cancer, we d like to see it as the fifth most funds for research.
