

# Classics Against Cancer 2017 rolls into town Sunday

Get ready for Summer 2017 with the Classics Against Cancer Father's Day Show in Cedarvale Park, on the banks of the Credit River June 18.

After a long winter, vintage car and truck enthusiasts love to get their motor running and shine up the chariot for a day of fun. Classics Against Cancer has been the unofficial doorway to summer for car fans.

Classics Against Cancer was initiated in 1988 by local businessman Neil Young along with a dozen of his friends.

The idea was to combine a classical concert with a car show as a backdrop to the music and park setting. The show returned in 1989 to become a yearly attraction for car fans. It was hot from the start with the inaugural event drawing such choice vehicles such as a Model J. Duesenberg and two vintage Ferraris, including a rare Spyder model.

The Duesenberg was a Pebble Beach Best in Show honours winner. The driving force behind all these wonderful cars showing up is the battle against cancer. This year the proceeds go towards the Childhood Cancer Campaign.

This time Classics Against Cancer celebrates 30 years of hosting one of the best known events in Southern Ontario with new ideas being added

yearly. Attendance records have exceeded 5,000 in some years. The 2014 show signalled a renaissance with high attendance and very favourable comments. The 2015 show built on the momentum with new displays. The show averages 400 cars and receives 4,000 visitors annually. The committee has been able to raise more than \$500,000 since the first show.

For 2017 the show is offering a mix of favourites in live entertainment. Rolly Rocker & the Hemi Heads with Lee Martin is returning to the stage, supplying classic 50s to 70s rock done in unique Hemi Heads style. Monty Greig and other amazing performers will be present. There will be fun and games for kids of all ages as well.

The special auto attractions include a Cruise-In Style format along with radio controlled NAS-CAR stock car racing experience. North America and European cars will be on show.

New this year is a special Century of Service Vehicles with police, fire, army and ambulance displays throughout the decades. Through the years as our village and towns grew, these professional vehicles stood on guard for us. It's a fitting tie-in with Canada's own 150th anniversary.
