Waterstock rallies bottled water opponents

Wellington Water Watchers and the founders of Riverfest Elora organized Waterstock at the Erin Fairgrounds on Sunday, June 11, a festival designed to focus pressure on the Ontario government to phase out the bottled water industry.

The event featured fine food from celebrity chefs,

public speakers, artists and entertainers including Digging Roots, Reuben Bullock, Oh Suzanna and Jim Cuddy from Blue Rodeo.

Activists particularly object to Nestlé Waters Canada being allowed to pump millions of litres of groundwater each year from wells in Hillsburgh and Aberfoyle, to the environmental harm caused by discarded plastic water

bottles and to the impact of trucking the water.

A recent statement from Nestlé says the company "is committed to a sustainable and prospering Town of Erin and Province of Ontario. We believe all conversations about sustainability, managing and protecting water are positive and we are encouraged by the passion shown by all parties."

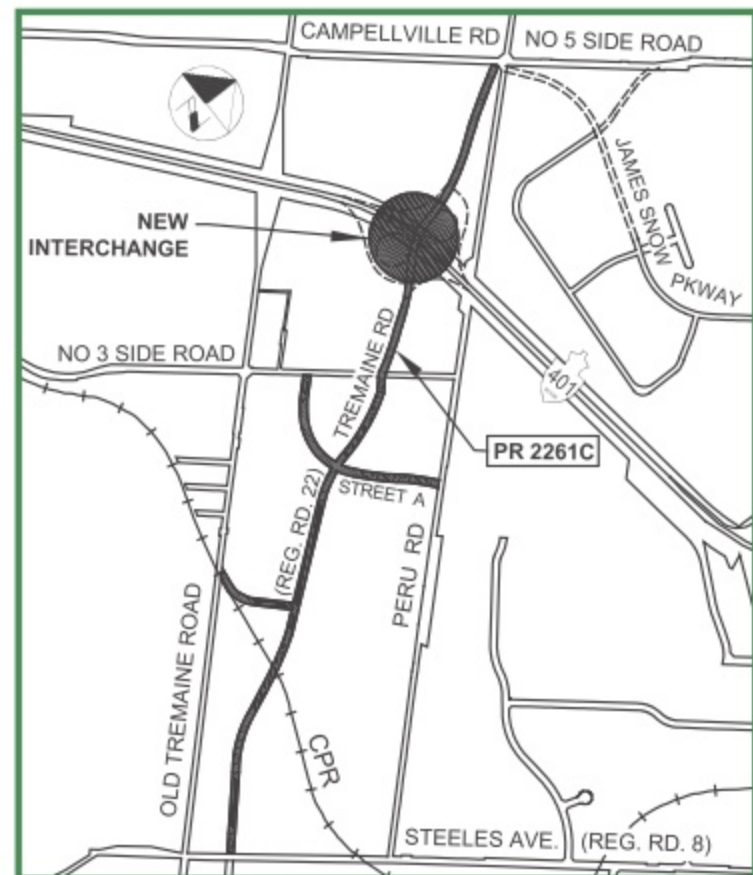
