Back in October, Lippa received a letter from Green party leader Elizabeth May, congratulating him on his status as the youngest honorary member. To celebrate, Lippa's father tweeted the news out, but people were less than friendly.

"When he tweeted out the news, there were trolls who responded with, 'How dare you brainwash your kid,'" Bascom said. "That was a good lesson on the Internet and trolls, and how to not take things personally and not respond. We just had to let that go."

"The important thing is the clarity around this being Spencer's mission,"

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Bascom said. "He really has taken this on himself, and we've supported him in his devotion to the cause. We didn't plant it; we didn't feed it; we just said, 'OK.' And we're really proud of him."

Although he received backlash, he also received validation: Elizabeth May responded to his tweet, and wants to sit down with Lippa in the future.

"To see your child become passionate about something . if it were trains or I don't know what else, I'd probably be just as delighted," Bascom said. "It's thrilling and it makes him happy, and for him to put his

money where his mouth is is huge."

Lippa has dreams of becoming a public speaker for the Green party and becoming actively involved in debates.

"I want to tell people how I feel about this stuff," he said. "I'm good at standing up in front of a crowd, and I also think I could change people's minds and make them think twice about the environment."

Because of his age, Lippa doesn't know whether or not that will help or harm him - and for the people who doubt him, he has a special message.

"You were a kid once as well."

Notice of the Passing of an Amending Education Development Charges By-law

TAKE NOTICE that on the 21st day of June, 2017, the Halton District School Board (the "Board") passed Education Development Charges Amending By-law, 2017, which amends the Education Development Charges By-law, (2013) of the Board.

AND TAKE NOTICE that any person or organization may appeal the By-law to the Ontario Municipal Board under Section 257.65 of the Education Act by filing with the Secretary of the Halton District School Board on or before the 31st day of July, 2017, a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the By-law and the reasons supporting the objection. The appeal may not raise an issue that could have been raised in an appeal under Section 257.65 of the Education Act of Education Development Charges By-law, (2013).

The said amending By-law comes into force on June 26, 2017, and increases the education development charge on residential development to \$4,364.00 per dwelling unit and the education development charge on non-residential development to \$1.11 per square foot (\$11.95 per square metre) of gross floor area. No other amendment to Education Development Charges By-law, (2013) has been made in the amending By-law.
