The event will feature all the ribs you can eat from

Brampton man charged with indecent acts in Georgetown

A 24-year-old man has been arrested and charged with several offences, including committing an indecent act, following incidents last Thursday afternoon (Aug. 3).

Two separate 911 calls to Halton Regional Police reported a man masturbating on the walking trail of the Hungry Hollow ravine in Georgetown.

Police were initially responding to a 911 call from a woman reporting that a half-naked male was performing an indecent act upon himself while shouting over to her and attempting to entice her into a wooded area.

While searching for the suspect, officers were alerted by another woman trying to call 911 to report a

man performing an indecent act upon himself in plain view on a bench in the same vicinity.

Officers, including the canine unit, found the male moments later.

Police allege he was still performing an indecent act in plain public view.

After being transported to 12 Division in Milton, the suspect was interviewed by detectives.

Connor James Sprayson of Brampton is charged with two counts of committing an indecent act, three counts of breaching probation, one count of breaching prohibition order and one count of possession of a controlled substance (marijuana).
