OMA elects Georgetown doctor as new president

The Ontario Medical Association (OMA) has a new president-elect, and her name may seem familiar to folks in Georgetown.

Dr. Nadia Alam, a family physician and anesthesiologist based in Georgetown, was elected to her new role at the end of May. Alam operates a family practice out of her offices on Sinclair Avenue.

Her election follows her appointment to the OMA board earlier this year after the previous executive board stepped down amid controversy surrounding ongoing contract talks with the province.
