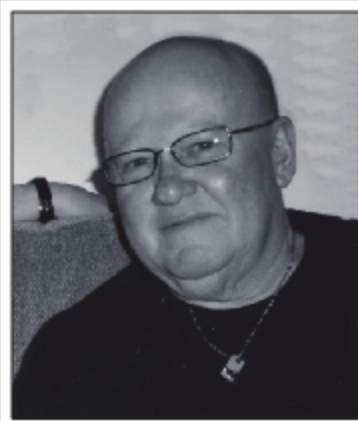

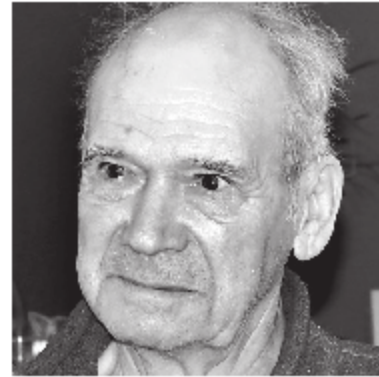
**McLVEEN, Irene**

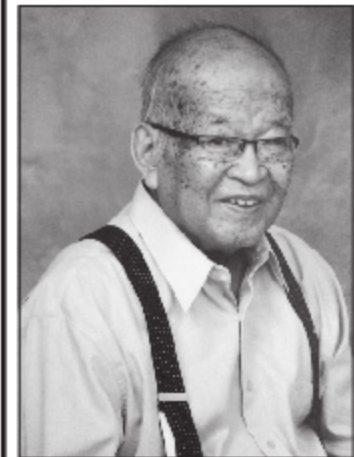
