I just remarried. Do I need a new will?

In Ontario, if you had a will at the time of remarriage, then the will you had is void or revoked on marriage, unless the will was made in the contemplation of marriage. In order for your will to reflect that it was made in the contemplation of marriage, it must have a provision that confirms the pending marriage as well as the name of your intended spouse. Without these provisions being met, then the will in existence on the date of marriage will not be valid on marriage. If you do not have a will or a valid will on death then you are said to have died "intestate", and reference to the provisions under Ontario's Succession Law Reform Act must be referred to in order to determine what is to happen with your estate. Having a will enables you to decide how your estate is to be divided in the event of your death, and it is certainly a lot simpler, and can avoid a lot of uncertainty and expense that may arise if you do not have a will. When doing a will, it is a good idea to consider whether you have a power of attorney in place with respect to person and property, and, if you do, whether there needs to be any changes to those to better reflect your current situation.
