

The flyover was in honour of Halton Hills officially earning the title of Canada's Most Patriotic Town after breaking the record for the most Canadian flags flown within a town on Canada Day. Residents in Halton Hills flew 57,073 flags on Canada's 150th birthday, shattering the old record by tens of thousands of flags.
