will promote healthy environments for pollinators. We hope these efforts will contribute to maintaining pollinator populations and allow these species to thrive in our community for generations to come,' he added.

Currently in the planning stages, Benson said a work plan will be brought forward as part of the region's 2018 Budget and Business Plan.

For its part, Halton Hills council voted unanimously in support of furthering the initiative locally in Halton Hills and instructed town staff to look into ways to do so at its regular meeting on Aug. 28.

"Sustainability is a strategic priority of Council so it makes sense that Halton Hills would support pollinator initiatives." said mayor Rick Bonnette. "There should be some good 'buzz' around this."

"As a bee keeper myself, I know only too well the importance of supporting pollinator initiatives. added councillor Bob Inglis.

According to a Government of Ontario Pollinator Health fact sheet found on its website, bees are the most common pollinator with more than 700 species native to Canada. Other pollinators include butterflies, moths, wasps, flies, hummingbirds and some species of beetle.

Many crops in Ontario including apples, cherries, peaches, plums, cucumbers, asparagus, squash, pumpkins, melons, blueberries, cranberries and many others rely on pollinators.

"Improving the health of bees and other pollinators is a necessity. Without pollinators, much of the food we eat and the natural habitats we enjoy would not exist," says the provincial government on its website. "The decline of these pollinators is a serious problem that requires immediate action to ensure that Ontario's food system and natural environment are protected."

According to the province's research, bee winter die-off rates averaged approximately 34 per cent over the 12 years leading up to 2014 and has been increasing annually. The generally accepted level is around 15 per cent.

"In 2010-2011, winter mortality rate for honey bees was 43 per cent. In 2012-13 the rate was 38 per cent. Last winter the mortality rate reached its highest level at 58 per cent," writes the province, adding pesticide use is a major concern for pollinator population health.
