Georgetown District High School Rebels are no longer

Students returning to classes earlier this month at Georgetown District High School learned that after more than a half century, the association with the nickname Rebels has ended.

School officials actually came to a decision back in June that the word Rebels and the Georgetown District High School (GDHS) sports' teams blue and red colours bore too close a resemblance to the controversial Confederate flag, and while that flag was removed from all school imagery nearly 30 years ago, the move to discard the name was made in the spirit of inclusivity.

This doesn't mean, however, that any historical mention, hallway display photos or existing team uniforms - such as that of this year's senior boys' hockey
