The Terra Cotta Country Store will be buzzing with activity this weekend as store owners Judy Vella and Bob McCloskey kick off their fifth annual folk-style festival.

With an eclectic mix of locally-based artisan and food vendors nestled under the willow trees along the Credit River, Buzzfest is the perfect place to spend a Saturday afternoon.

"How could you not want to spend a weekend there," said returning vendor Skytree Smith. "It is such a beautiful place and the people who come are fantastic. You can grab some food, peruse some art and really just relax and take it all in."

Smith will be returning for the fourth year in a row with pieces from her handblown glass business, Elemental Glassworks, which operates out of Williams Mill in Glen Williams just a few minutes away.

And Smith's artwork will be on display in

There will be handmade bath soaps and salts, hot sauces, crochet work, a Lebanese specialty to munch on called zaatar, Golden Rescue Ambassadors, handmade wood signs and so much more to choose from on-site.

The festival originally began five years ago after someone was admiring McCloskey's photography work and told him that he should showcase his work in a little event at the store, Vella explained.

"We thought it was a great idea but that it might be a little lonely for him to do it himself, so we decided to ask a few people to join," she continued.

"The best little seeds start in moments like that, and here we are today."

With more than 2,000 attendees in 2016, both Vella and McCloskey are excited to see what their fifth anniversary festival has in store for them.

"We have had tons of grassroots support from the first year that we hosted this and being a family-run festival we count on all that good will that we receive locally," Vella concluded. "We are so excited to welcome everyone back this year and see some new fac-
