The Elmer Iseler singers perform

The Elmer Iseler Singers are coming to town. Yes, those Elmer Iseler Singers are returning to St. John's United Church to perform the closing concert of the third annual Inspiring Spaces concert series.

This 20-voice, fully professional choral ensemble, founded by the late Dr. Elmer Iseler in 1979, has built a reputation throughout Canada, the United States and internationally through concerts, broadcasts and recordings - performing repertoire that spans 500 years, with a focus on Canadian composers.

The choir returns 10 years after their performance in St. John's with five members that sang that concert returning to sing this one. Designed specifically by conductor Lydia Adams for the acoustics of the recently renovated sanctuary of St. John's, the unique program will feature soloists in the choir and include choral works by Gustav Holst, John Newton, Ola Gjeilo, Erik Esensvalds, and Franz Schubert.

The Canada 150 portion of the program

features a cross-country sextet of songs by beloved Canadian arrangers and composers including Eleanor Daley, Paul Halley, and Rita MacNeil.

Also performed will be Canadian Hussein Janmohamed's work Nur meaning "light," a piece commissioned by Adams for the Elmer Iseler singers for the opening of the Aga Khan Museum in Toronto and broadcast to millions of people throughout the world.

When you come to the concert on Saturday night, you will have the rare pleasure of hearing this exceptional Canadian choir in the intimate space of St. John's. Plan to stay for the reception afterward and meet members of the choir, guest conductor Shawn Grenke, pianist Krista Rhodes and the concert series' artistic director, pianist Carolyn Maule.
