You can file the separation agreement with the court. When you file your separation agreement, Attach it to a Form 26B: Affidavit for Filing Domestic Contract or Paternity Agreement, and take it to your local courthouse. You can file your separation agreement at the Ontario Court of Justice or the Family Court branch of the Superior Court of Justice. Once your separation agreement has been filed with the court, it will be sent to the Family Responsibility Office ("FRO"). The FRO is a government agency that collects support payments from the payor, i.e. the person who has to pay the support, whether child or spousal support. The FRO can do a number of things to ensure payment is made pursuant to the separation agreement, including garnish the payor's wages, garnish bank accounts and investments, seize federal monies coming to the payor such as a tax return, suspend the payor's driver's licence, or, in the worst cases, ask the court to put the payor in jail.
