# African Children's Choir coming to Acton

The African Children's Choir is headed to Acton. Consisting of children from Uganda aged eight to 10, the night will be energy-packed and full of enthusiasm.

According to tour leader Keira Carnie, the concert will be approximately 18 minutes in length. All the children play instruments, 17 of them playing drums, and will partake in tribal dances.

"You can feel the energy and the enthusiasm," Carnie said. "It really comes across in the concert."

By partaking in the concert, all the children have their schooling paid for, all the way up to university. All proceeds raised through the concert pave the way for future choir members, and in some cases, friends of current members back home.

"It's a lifelong commitment to these children," Carnie said.

The group has been touring the U.S. since April, and will tour around Canada for six weeks. The event is free, with a goodwill offering suggestion, and everyone in the community is invited to attend.

"It's a really uplifting, joyous evening," Carnie

said. "Everyone comes out smiling. They're exhausted because of the high energy, but they see the joy and hope and dignity of these kids, and these are the things why this was started."

Carnie said the performance is the children's favourite part of the trip, and where they come from doesn't determine their future and their outlook on life.
