The Mayor of Halton Hills says he's pleased following the unanimous passing of a private member's resolution brought forward by Wellington-Halton Hills MPP Ted Arnott at Queen's Park last week.

Arnott brought the resolution, focusing on addressing Halton Hills' many transportation issues, forward in the Ontario legislature on Thursday Sept. 28.

"The fact that MPP Arnott brought this request forward is a great example of different levels of government working together; after all there is only one taxpayer. I'm hopeful that we can take this to the next level and look to the province for funding support when we get to the point of looking at viable alternatives," said Mayor Rick Bonnette in a release.
