## Norval intersection, truck traffic discussed at regional council

An intersection featuring dangerous truck traffic in Norval has been petitioned, heard by Halton Hills council and has now been heard at regional council.

On Oct. 4, during the Region of Halton's planning and public works committee meeting, the issue was brought forward by Halton Hills Coun. Clark Somerville, as were the concerns from residents regarding the busy intersection.

According to Somerville, the intersection has a number of issues: there are a number of jurisdictions on it, including the Ministry of Transportation; it is a boundary road for Halton but


