

### Launch of Library's 'Wifi to Go' program

As some will have seen, The Halton Hills Public Library has a new service they've begun to offer. Starting Wednesday, October 18, the library has started their new mobile internet program under the name "Wifi to Go".

Patrons are able to borrow portable internet hotspots that, according to a release, "may be used from the comfort of their homes or on the go." The devices connect to a local network from wherever the individual is trying to use the device. Providing a network is available in that area, the user will be able to connect their phone, computer or other piece of technology to the

"The new ZTE Mobile Internet devices have the ability to connect up to 15 devices at one time, with battery life lasting up to eight hours," continues the release, "The sleek portable device is compact to carry home and makes staying connected easier than ever."

Halton Hills Public Library Chief Librarian Geoff Cannon said, "We're very excited to offer this new service. We understand that many people don't have access to the internet, or simply can't afford it. Internet access is essential for many people: this is a great opportunity to give back to our community, and a perfect time to share the announcement during Ontario Public Library Week."

There are three devices at the Georgetown branch of the library and one at the Acton branch. That being said, they can be requested through the library's Inter-Library Loan program, allowing Acton users access to the devices in the Georgetown branch.

Each borrowed device has instructions for initial use, a "cheat sheet" for first time users of the technology.

As of Tuesday, October 24, there was a wait list for the devices.
