FIRE REPORT

Monday, October 30

At 9:13 a.m. firefighters responded to an ambulance assist on Third Line in Erin. On scene, fire staff provided patient care until ambulance arrived.

Tuesday, October 31

At 4:48 p.m. firefighters responded to the report of a garbage bin fire on Queen St. E in Acton. On scene, fire staff met with building personnel who had just finished extinguishing the fire. Crews confirmed the fire was out and cleared the scene.

5:53 p.m. firefighters responded to the report of a pedestrian struck by a vehicle in the area of Mill and Main St. Halton Regional Paramedics and Halton Regional Police advised fire was not required.

Thursday, November 2

At 9:52 a.m. firefighters responded to an ambulance assist on Greenore Cres. in Acton. On scene, fire staff assisted Halton Regional Paramedics with loading the patient into the ambulance and cleared the scene.

6:54 p.m. firefighters responded to a burn complaint on Acton Blvd. in Acton. On scene, fire staff met with the homeowner who did not have a valid burn permit. The fire was extinguished and the burn permit process was explained for any future burns.

10:02 p.m. firefighters responded to the report of a vehicle fire in the area of Regional Road 25 and 10 Sideroad. On scene, fire staff found the engine compartment of the vehicle fully involved and spreading to the passenger compartment. Fire staff quickly extinguished the fire with no further concerns.

Friday, November 3

At 4:13 p.m. firefighters responded to a burn complaint on 15 Sideroad. On scene, fire staff met with

the homeowner who did have a valid burn permit and was burning within the parameters of the burn permit. No further concerns.

5:49 p.m. firefighters responded to a burn complaint on Sixth Line. On scene, fire staff met with the homeowner who did have a valid burn permit but was not burning within the regulations of the permit. The fire was extinguished.

Too many children die in fires they start themselves, so adults must keep all fire-starting materials out of sight and reach of children. If you smoke, have only one lighter and keep it with you at all times.

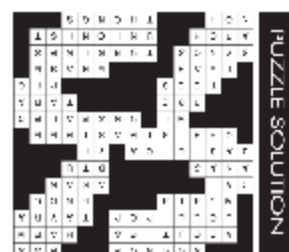
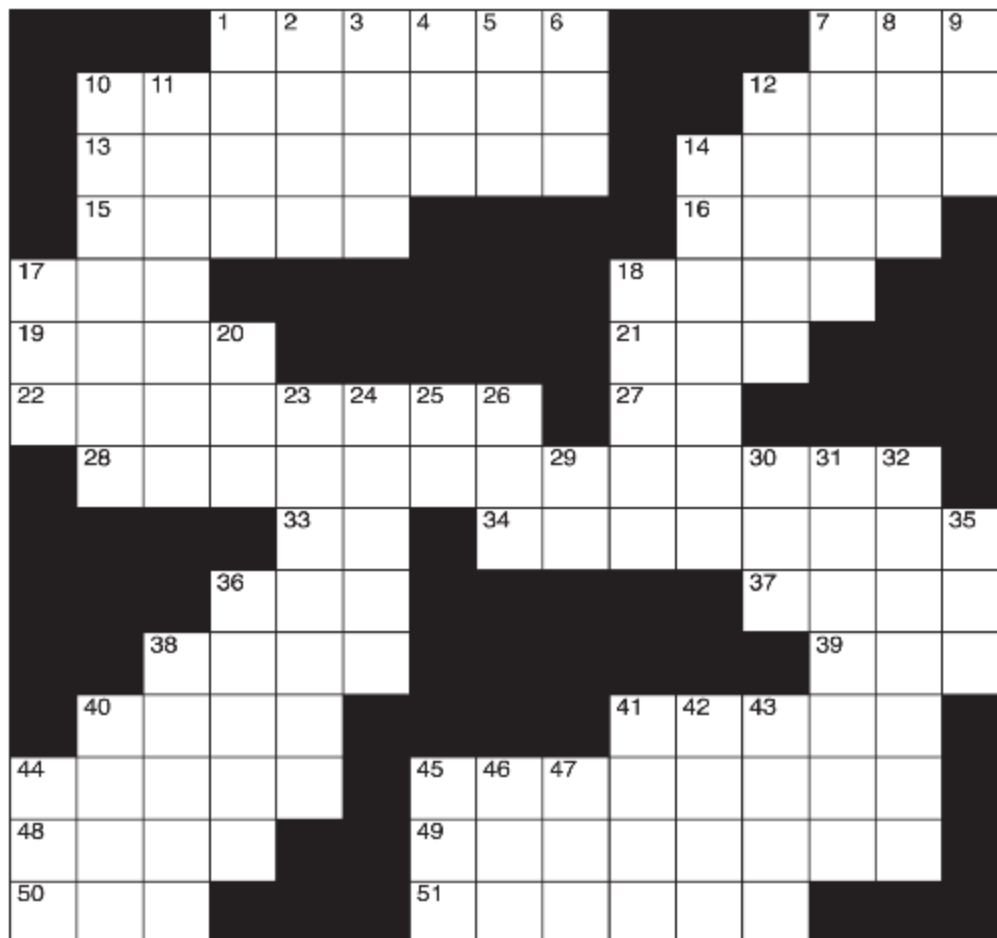
