

Capital budget for 2018 approved at \$18.9M

budget for 2018 was approved at \$18,934,900.

The approved proposed capital budget will next go before council for final approval, with the town's operating budget to be considered at the beginning of December.

The operating budget is estimated to come in at \$103,700.

Among the major capital projects receiving funding this year are a number of road, intersection and infrastructure projects, new equipment, software and materials for the library, and a new skate park in Georgetown.

"The preparation of the proposed capital budget involved a careful review and ranking exercise by representatives from every department as well as the se-

nior management team," said staff in the report.

The town employed a special scoring matrix in order to rank planned capital projects based on priority.

The report provided to the budget committee also outlined the results of the town's 2015 Citizen Satisfaction Survey, the third such survey conducted by the town and first since 2011.

According to the report, the purpose of the survey was to measure the level of satisfaction and the level of importance related to several services provided by the town.

"Based on the findings of the 2015 research, the quality of life in the town has moved slightly higher compared to the last two surveys with a solid 9 out of 10 respondents rating posi-

tively on this measure.

Significantly more citizens rated the quality of life as 'excellent' in 2015, compared to 2011 and 2005.

The most pronounced gains in resident satisfaction were seen in recreation and culture, safety/community services and planning and development. Growth and development was cited as the most important issue for residents, followed by transportation and infrastructure.
