Proposed Amendment to the Regional Official Plan

"An Amendment to Address a Shortfall of Employment Lands in the Town of Halton Hills' Premier Gateway Employment Area" Applicant: Halton Region

The Council of the Regional Municipality of Halton, through its Planning and Public Works Committee, is holding a Public Meeting to provide the public an opportunity to comment on a proposed Amendment to the Regional Official Plan pursuant to Section 17 of the Planning Act.

Purpose and Effect: The purpose of the proposed Regional Official Plan Amendment is to address the shortfall of employment lands in the Town of Halton Hills by incorporating lands north of the Premier Gateway Employment Area in the "Draft Amendment Area" into the Region's Urban Area as shown on Map 1 of the Regional Official Plan. The effect of the proposed Amendment is to ensure there is sufficient employment land available for development in the pre-2021 phase, consistent with the growth strategy set out in the Regional Official Plan.

Location: The proposed Regional Official Plan Amendment applies to the lands in the Town of Halton Hills identified as the "Draft Amendment Area" in the map to the right.

Other Applications: The Town of Halton Hills will be initiating a corresponding Local Official Plan Amendment. The lands subject to the proposed Amendment are also being planned as a part of the Town of Halton Hills' Premier Gateway Phase 1B Integrated Planning Project (File: D08 Phase 1B Secondary Plan).

All information including names, addresses, opinions, presentations, reports, documentation, etc. provided for or at a Public Meeting are considered public records. This information may be posted on Halton Region's website and/or made available to the public upon request. The Public Meeting will be streamed and a video of the meeting will be made available on Halton Region's website.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to Halton Region before the proposed official plan amendment is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal Halton Regional Council's decision to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make a written submission to Halton Region before the proposed official plan amendment is adopted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or the public body as a party.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of Halton Region on the proposed official plan amendment, you must make a written request to the Regional Clerk, Regional Municipality of Halton, Regional Clerk's Office, 1151 Bronte Road, Oakville, ON, L6M 3L1.
