Resident fed up with speeders after deadly crash

Ballinafad resident Mark Gagne has had enough with motorists dangerously speeding through his neighbourhood.

Gagne placed a homemade sign at the end of his driveway on Halton-Erin Townline urging motorists to slow down following a fatal collision under a kilometre from his home early on Saturday.

"We've had multiple cars and trucks travelling by our house at a raised speed of probably 120 kilometres per hour for years

now," said Gagne, indicating the speed limit is only 50 km/h in front of his home.

"My wife and I have lived at that farm for five years now, and the number of accidents we can count over that time is just through the roof," he added. "It's a straightaway. We hear certain

trucks come down Trafalgar Road and turn west to come down our road, and these guys have got their foot down right past our place.'

"It's a residential area with the local community centre right
