there. There are kids out walking (and) there are people walking their dogs. Just past my laneway, it tapers off and goes up to 70 km/h. Even those who do slow down in the 50 km/h zone gun it when they get to the 70 km/h zone," said Gagne.

On Saturday, Oct. 21, at approximately 7:30 a.m., Said Saleh, a 37-year-old Brampton man, was killed when his Kia SUV collided head on with a Dodge minivan just seconds from Gagne's home.

A passenger in the Kia was sent to hospital with non-life-threatening injuries, while the 20-year-old

driver was sent to a trauma centre with life-altering injuries. The man driving the minivan remains in hospital in serious condition.

Gagne says he and several neighbours have been concerned for years someone would eventually be killed along that stretch of road. After Saturday's fatality, he decided to take things into his own hands and put up a sign reading: "Slow Down - One death is one to (sic) many".

"I've had enough. I'm tired of watching these cars go by (at these speeds)," he said.

Gagne said he intends to bring the matter to Halton Hills council in hopes of eventually having some speed bumps and additional signage installed.

"My motivation is to slow people down by the signage, and try to get the message across that there's people actually dying on this road," he said. "I'm going to attempt to get a hold of council and see about getting a couple of speed bumps put in the 50 km/h zone."
