After 35 years serving on Halton Hills council, Mayor Rick Bonnette says he might not seek another term in next year's election

He also did not rule out the possibility either, telling those in attendance he would make his decision by spring.

Halton Hills, he was first elected to council at the age of 27. He maintained that role until being elected mayor in 2003. He is currently serving his fourth term in the mayor's chair.

In 2008, Bonnette was honoured by the province with the Long-Standing Service Award. He was also a recipient of the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal in 2012 for his many years of service.

The 2018 municipal election is scheduled for Oct. 22 of next year.

Halton police urge Acton residents to keep unattended vehicles locked up

Statistics show that the bulk of the thefts are occurring during overnight

Plaza parking lots and

other shopping areas have been targeted by thieves, who are looking for vehicles with holiday gifts inside.

Items visible from the outside such as laptops, cellphones, purses, wallets, credit cards or loose cash are also vulnerable to theft, said Staff Sgt. Paul Davies.

"Our uniformed officers

and Criminal Investigation Bureau Detectives continue to tackle the issue and several arrests have been made in connection with these thefts," he said.

Davies noted that rural areas are being victimized as well and suggests that exterior lights be kept on overnight as a deterrent from nighttime thieves.
