The Town is expanding both Mold-Masters SportsPlex and Acton Arena and Community Centre.

The Mold-Masters expansion will cost about \$18.9 million and see two new NHL-sized rinks added, along with six new larger dressing rooms, four new referee rooms, additional seating, and a new meeting space/activity room for community groups. It is to be completed by the end of September.

One additional NHL-sized ice pad will be added at the Acton Arena, along with six new dressing rooms, two referee rooms, additional seating at a projected cost of \$10.3 million. That project is to be complete in the fall of 2015.
