Georgetown artist Barbara Ariss-Stroh-Wasser presents a solo art exhibit, Individualism within Globalism, at the Williams Mill Visual Arts Centre Gallery on Main St. in Glen Williams.

In her opinion, the advancement will only take place if the brain power of strong individuals connect; otherwise globalism will lead to a mass of sameness.

Specifically for this exhibit, she is inspired by images of the brains' neural network and fractal patterns in nature. In general, as a conceptual visual artist she transforms ideas into images. Her paintings capture the dynamic flow of energies surrounding us. She searches for new ways of visual expression, achieving this by blending unconventional materials in unusual combinations.

As a special feature, the early part of the reception will offer a vocal classical music performance

Ariss-Stroh-Wasser currently exhibits at the Meadowvale Theatre in Mississauga, and the Milton Town Hall, soon to be followed by solo shows in Toronto and the Holcim Gallery in the Milton.

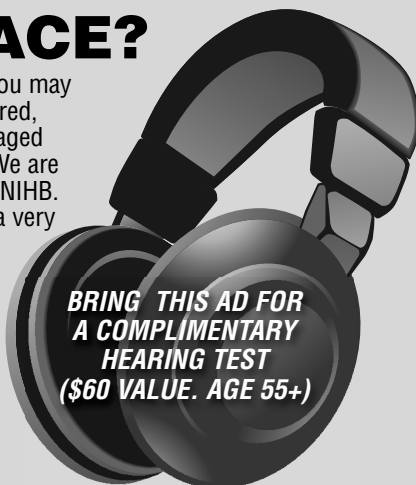
