MAN HIT WITH ANTI-RIOT WEAPON SPARKS SIU INVESTIGATION

An incident involving a Georgetown man and the Halton Regional Police has led to an investigation by the Special Investigations Unit. The province's police watchdog is investigating circumstances surrounding an incident that took place at a Georgetown home on Jan. 22.

That afternoon, a citizen went to a police station to report her concerns over a family member. As a result, Halton police officers were dispatched to a residence in the area of Delrex Blvd and Mountainview Rd. S. Officers began negotiating with a 46-year-old man who was barricaded in the residence.

When the man left the

residence, he was involved in an altercation with police, resulting in one officer deploying an Arwen gun, which fires plastic projectiles. The man was then taken to hospital to be treated for a serious injury.

Three investigators and one forensic investigator have been assigned to the case. One subject officer and seven witness officers have been designated at this time. The SIU investi-

gates reports involving police where there has been death, serious injury or allegations of sexual assault.

The SIU is urging anyone who may have information regarding this investigation to contact the lead investigator at 1-800-787-8529. The SIU is also urging anyone with video evidence related to the incident to upload the video through the SIU website at www.siu.on.ca.
