


Bahamian artist featured at Williams Mill

International watercolour artist Sheldon Saint will be featuring a collection of his works—Bahamas Treasure—in the Williams Mill Gallery until Sunday, Feb. 4. Meet Saint at an opening reception tonight (6-9 p.m.).

Saint has travelled from the Bahamas with former Halton Hills resident Bob Tarzwell, who is a guest artist in the show and is supporting Saint's entrance into the international arts forum.

"Bahamas Treasure is my first international art exhibit and I welcome the Halton Hills community to... join me in celebration as I bring a journey into the life of the Bahamas that I so treasure," he says.

Saint is recognized as one who captures the natural beauty and grace of the everyday island life. A self-taught artist who has been painting professionally for more than 20 years, he creates detailed works of art in oil, watercolor,

"My paintings offer a life that Bahamians live and have lived," says Saint. "The colors I choose are not bold and often my compositions mimic the simple everyday life of my subject and their world that I find so intriguing. My paintings tell us who we are, remind us of the delicacy, simplicity, abundance and dignity of our natural environment and shows humankind co-mingled with it."

Tarzwell says, "Sheldon is featured in the October edition of the *Watercolor Artist Magazine* (www.watercolorartistmagazine.com) and is an exciting creative source for the future of Bahamian artwork. This is a chance to view the exquisite work locally at the Williams Mill Gallery."
