

The 2013 Cultural Symposium to be held this weekend at the new library

The 2013 Cultural Symposium gets underway this Friday and Saturday, Feb. 1 and 2 at the new Georgetown library.

The Cultural Symposium is an annual event, hosted by the Halton Hills Cultural Roundtable, designed to improve and encourage the business of culture, heritage and arts in the community.

On Saturday morning at the optional 8 a.m. breakfast brainstorm, participants will talk about how to jointly increase visual arts sales and display opportunities throughout the community.

At 9:30 a.m. is the welcome, followed by information on the soon-to-be

launched MyHaltonHills community website. The AGM begins at 10 a.m. After a break, participants will have a chance to have input on the proposed Cultural Master Plan. After an in-house lunch provided by Glen Oven and McGibbon, participants will have the options of two workshops:

- Branding and Marketing You, by Paul Copcutt.

And, if you still want more, check out the 3:30-7 p.m. add-on Watercolor Workshop being held at the Williams Mill Education Centre and offered at a reduced fee of \$25 to Symposium participants.

The event is being held mostly in the Helson Gallery this year, which is still under construction, so dress is very casual. Members will be collecting spare change during the event to buy as a collective one or more theatre chairs (they are \$750 each) as part of the current fundraising efforts for the overall site.
