The Baby Talk Group is a free group that runs every Friday, between 10:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m., at St. George's Anglican Church, in the Lounge.

Baby Talk is facilitated by Vikki Kidd, IBCLC (International Board Certified Lactation Consultant) and Kyle Jones NNEB, (UK Nursery Nurse) who both give their time voluntarily.

## Aims of the group:

- Provide a warm and friendly, café style environment for new mothers with babies (newborn to mobile) to meet.
- To encourage these mothers to mix and build support networks with others going through similar life experiences.
- Encourage mothers to share and discuss their parenting experiences, ideas and anxieties, and ask those 'crazy' questions.
- For coordinators to offer support and up-to-date evidence-based parenting information in a non-judgemental manner.

Each session the facilitator encourages a parenting related topic for discussion. This is often based on a topic that has recently been in the media. If possible the coordinator also answers any of the mother's questions or 'sign post' them to where they might find the answer.

# GAC offers free community lunch on Saturday



Nominations are currently being accepted for the following categories: Business of the Year; Green Award; Employee of the Year; Entrepreneur of the Year.



## Hey kids, join a book club beginning this month


There's still time to join Halton Hills Public Library's book club for kids called the Cocoa Club.
