The Farm Assessment Public Forum, put on by the Town of Halton Hills Council and the Halton Federation of Agriculture, will be held Thursday, Feb. 28 at 7 p.m. at the Civic Centre in the council chambers.

Mark Lindquist, the Provincial Farm Specialist for MPAC will make a pre-

sentation and be available to answer questions related to farm assessment.

"The Town does not mandate tax assessment and so this is a great opportunity for the farming community to have any concerns they have related to increased assessment addressed directly by MPAC," said Mayor Rick Bonnette.

There was a child in that vehicle with the driver. No one was injured, however, the driver of the Torrent was checked out at Georgetown Hospital. Charged with impaired driving and having over 80 mg of alcohol in 100 ml of blood is Garnet Leblanc, 46.

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
