## Artist regrets not speaking at council meeting

delegation but withdrew after hearing from Alyman.

In an email to Mayor Rick Bonnette copied to this newspaper Wednesday Kremer said she felt her presentation would be redundant especially because he and Councillor Jane Fogal had apologized in a meeting with the artists and asked them to look ahead instead of trying to sort out blame.

But after hearing Somerville say at the meeting it was only a vocal minority of artists upset about the Gallery issue, she wishes she had spoken, Kremer said.

"I would like to reiterate that none of our local artists do anything but appreciate Mr. Helson's gift. We just wish to share the wall space of the new Gallery by dividing the time between the Helson Collection and the local artists. We are large in number and we have the additional support of over 100 independent people at this point," said Kremer.

In the meeting, Somerville said he was glad to see "a bit more sober second thought" coming from the disgruntled artists. He said he never thought he would have

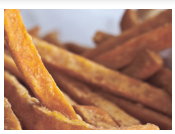
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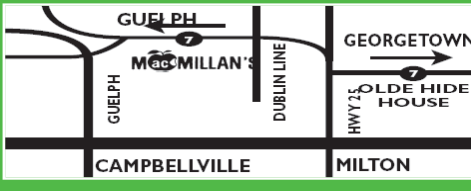
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
