

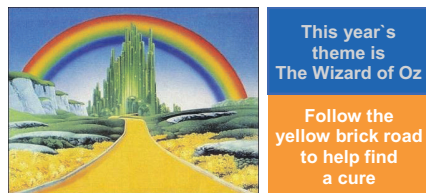

## Police blotter: Driver faces charges

A 22-year-old Georgetown man is facing charges after Halton Police stopped a driver who failed to stop at a stop sign at Miller Dr. and Hepburn Ave. about 1 a.m. Saturday.

Charged with impaired driving and refusing to provide a breath sample is Andrew Meaniss.

Police are investigating an attempted break and enter into a Sixth Line home about 1:20 p.m. last Wednesday.

The homeowner called out when someone walked through the unlocked front door and she heard a voice.

The suspect fled in a dark-coloured vehicle. There were two people in the vehicle, a male driver, and female passenger who was wearing a dark jacket and dark clothing.

A 15 Sideroad home was entered between 9 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. Mar. 13. The rear door of the home was forced open to gain entry. Nothing was taken.

Police report a significant amount of "disturbing" graffiti was found on the walls of the elevator and laundry room in a Park Ave. apartment building Monday. There was also food strewn about the laundry room.
