

Hotel may get reprieve from demolition

let you know we are looking at this opportunity. Ultimately, at the end of the day, if we can help our community, then our community will help us."

Gerrard said four 1-2 bedroom units or mixed residential/commercial would be required on the site to make the project worthwhile. The heritage property would then be turned over to an overseer group to raise funds to move, renovate and maintain.

The Friends of Devereaux House has stepped forward to offer their services, said Councillor Moya Johnson.

Gerrard said his group, alerted about the site by Acton Councillor Jon Hurst, a Habitat volunteer, is investigating the site for its potential and may put in an offer tomorrow (Friday).

If they do, it would come at an opportune time—the heirs of the property filed for a demolition permit on Monday, preempting a bid by Town Council to list the property on the Heritage Register later that night.

The Exchange Hotel was originally built in the 1850s but has had a number of additions, including a porch that encroaches onto the GO parking lot.

The Wright/Hillock family had owned and operated the hotel for about 100 years. The heirs of Dorothy Hillock now want to

demolish the deteriorating building and re-market the property.

But Heritage Halton Hills (HHH) says the central portion of the building is a rare example of a frame stagecoach-style railway hotel that is in proximity to a federally-designated train station, still in operation. HHH says that portion should be listed on the Heritage Register.

Infrastructure Services Director Chris Mills said demolition could happen anytime after the permit is approved, and because the structure is not listed on the Heritage Register, demolition would not have to wait the required 60 days.

However, the heirs' solicitor, Bert Arnold, said Monday his clients, who had just heard of the Habitat proposal that day, were willing to work with Habitat in their investigation, and would let the Town know the outcome as soon as possible so no Town money is wasted exploring other options.

Council approved "in principle" the listing of the property on the Town's Municipal Heritage Register "pending Town Solicitor's advice on any impacts of listing the said property after a demolition application has been received."

As well, council deferred a report that called for the hiring of a conservation architect to evaluate moving the pre-Confederation portion of the property off the site to an unused Town-owned lot on Union St.
