Saturday night will be the Big Homecoming dance at Memorial Arena with limited tickets. The dance will be featuring local talent such as Double Exposure, Neil Cotton, and Larry Melton. In 2007, this was the highlight of the weekend says Bergsma.

Price of the tickets are \$30 per per-

son for the dance. This will include a commemorative plastic cups with the Homecoming 2013 logo.

"The committee has started a green initiative where the cups will be needed for the dance for beverages," said Bergsma. "This is to reduce waste during our event."

Like the 2007 event, during the course of the weekend, the committee would like to open up the opportunity for local elementary, middle and high schools, clubs and organizations to host their own reunion.

"We would have the ability of adding all reunions to the Homecoming calendar and promote their event on Facebook, website, and newspaper," added Bergsma.

On Sunday, closing ceremonies of the Homecoming event will be 1 p.m. at the new Georgetown branch of the Halton Hills Library with a tour of how Homecoming 2007's donation was used.
