# Fawcett nets winner as Colts win game seven

Former Georgetown Raider forward Tyson Fawcett scored the game-winning goal Monday night for the Barrie Colts in game seven of their Ontario Hockey League East Conference championship series against the Belleville Bulls.

The 19-year-old from Barrie broke up a 1-1 tie with a deflection of a shot from the point during the second period and the Colts went on to a 3-1 road win, ending the junior career of local resident Stephen Silas, who spent five seasons

with the Bulls and has suited up for more regular-season and playoff games (368) than any other player in the franchise's history.

Fawcett, a 5-foot-7, 155-pound speedster, was expected by some in the Raiders' organization to return to Georgetown this past season, but he cracked the Colts' roster in training camp and has been a valued performer for head coach Dale Hawerchuk. He had nine goals and 17 assists in 62

games with Barrie this year and scored four game-winning goals during the Raiders' 2012 playoff run to the Ontario Junior Hockey League semifinals.

Silas, meanwhile, has said he will pursue a professional career. The 20-year-old had four goals and two assists and was +11 in 17 playoff games this spring.

The Colts now advance to the OHL Championship series against the top-ranked London Knights.

### NOXIOUS WEEDS

#### Notice to Property Owners: Destroy Noxious Weeds

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all persons in possession of land, in accordance with The Weed Control Act R.S.O. 1990, c. W.5., that unless weed seeds and noxious weeds growing on their lands within the Town of Halton Hills are destroyed by June 1, 2013 and throughout the season, the Town of Halton Hills may enter upon the said lands and have weeds destroyed, charging the costs against the land in taxes as set out in The Weed Control Act. The Town earnestly solicits co-operation of all property owners.

The purpose of the Weed Control Act is to reduce the impact of noxious weeds on land used for agricultural or horticultural purposes.

The Weed Control Act does not apply to noxious weeds or weed seeds on lands that are far enough away from any land used for agricultural purposes that they do not interfere with that use.

Please note that dandelions, burdock and goldenrod are NOT considered noxious weeds under The Weed Control Act.

For the information of all property owners, the following are designated as noxious weeds in the Town of Halton Hills:
