## Drug drop-off

Halton Regional Police hosted a Prescription Drug Drop-Off Day Saturday at various locations across Halton and collected more than 123 kilograms of prescription medication. These drugs included codeine, Demerol, diazepam, hydrocodone, hydromorphone, morphine, oxycodone, Percocet, Phenobarbital and several hundred needles. The province-wide public safety initiative encouraged Ontario residents to dispose of old and unused prescription medication in a secure, environmentally-friendly manner. In Halton Hills officers were collecting unwanted prescription drugs at the Acton 10 Division headquarters and in Georgetown at the Civic Centre. Prescription Drug Drop-off Day was supported by the Ontario Association of Chiefs of Police (OACP), the Government of Ontario, and Public Safety Canada.
