Formerly of Toronto. Peacefully in Georgetown Hospital on May 14th, 2013, surrounded by her family. Survived in Georgetown by her husband Brian of 59 years and by her daughter Mary (Hugh Crowther) and by her grandson, Geoffrey, to whom she was "Nonna"; by her son John (Barbara) Land of Kitchener; her brother the Rev. Edith was active in community agencies and matters all her life, helping to save Earl Bales Park from development. Living in North York for 31 years with many neighbours who were Holocaust survivors had a profound effect on Edith. Active in her church and in interfaith activities, Edith was presented in 1991 with the national Anglican Award of Merit and in 2010 received the Order of Niagara from her home diocese. 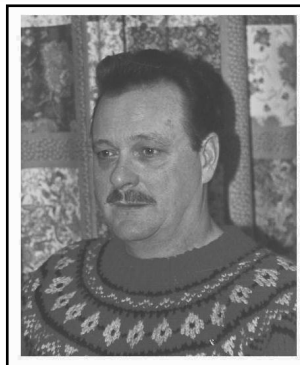
