A crane was being used to take down a tower at Holly Industries on Eastern Ave. in Acton Tuesday. The business has been closed since an explosion Nov. 8, 2012 that caused no injuries but resulted in the evacuation of several area residents. The company made sulfur granules out of molten sulfur. The Acton plant's parent company— Georgia Gulf Sulfur Corporation— has declined to comment about what was happening with Holly Industries. The 1.25-acre property is currently listed for sale by Colliers International. There is no asking price as the real estate company is requesting bids.
