

SPOTLIGHT ... on Cancer Society's Relay for Life

The eighth annual Canadian Cancer Society's Georgetown Relay for Life raised approximately \$70,000 with donations still coming in. The event, held at the Croatian Centre Friday/Saturday drew 25 teams with 250 members and 30 survivors. To date, Team Bison was the top fundraising team raising \$15,573 while Cancer Fighting Irish (\$6,167), Sister Act (\$5,562), Nashville North (\$5,535), and Sock It To Cancer (\$4,303) followed. The top individual fundraisers were Norm Sneyd (\$4,625) and Lisa Wagg (\$2,370) from Team Bison. More than \$74,000 was raised last year.
