Open house set to discuss Norval Quarry

The City of Brampton is hosting an open house on Wednesday, June 26 to present the findings of the second round of peer reviews and the social impact study related to the Norval Quarry proposal.

A drop-in open house will be held 6-8 p.m. at Peel Regional Police Association Meeting Hall, 10675 Mississauga Rd. in Brampton (two kilometres north of Hwy. 7).

Staff will report to Brampton council later this year with a final recommendation for the Norval Quarry rezoning application that considers the findings of the peer reviews, agency comments and public input.

In order to address the first of round of peer review findings, Brampton Brick submitted technical responses

in May 2012. The City commissioned a second round of peer reviews to consider the new information provided. The final reports are available on the project website, under the heading "Second Peer Review Reports (Spring 2013)." Representatives from the City's peer reviewers will be in attendance at the open house to respond to questions about their findings.
