The following materials are accepted free of charge at the Halton Waste Management Site:

- Electronics (cell phones, computers, monitors, TVs, stereos, DVD players, etc.) – up to 5 items per load
- Tires – up to 5 tires per load
- Household hazardous waste (paint, batteries, antifreeze, propane tanks, car oil) – up to 20 litre maximum per trip, no commercial waste

Customers are expected to sort their loads by material type. Please pre-sort your loads prior to delivery to Halton Waste Management Site for quick and easy unloading.

If required, customers should bring a family member or friend to help unload heavy material. Attendants are not permitted to assist customers with the unloading of materials.

- acids (rust remover)
- aerosol cans (full or partially full)
- antifreeze
- batteries (household & car)
- bleach
- cosmetics & pharmaceuticals
- fluorescent lights (compact bulbs & tubes)
- fertilizers
- fuels (must leave container)
- garden chemicals
- household cleaners
- medications
- motor oil & filters
- paint (full or partially full)
- pesticides
- pool chemicals
- propane tanks & other pressurized containers
- solvents
- stains
- varsol



✗ Unacceptable materials

- needles, syringes and lancets
- asbestos
- commercial and industrial hazardous waste
- PCBs
- explosives and ammunition

Electronics

✓ Acceptable materials

- computers
- stereos
- phones
- TVs
- VCRs
- DVD players
- computer monitors
- printers
- cell phones
- cameras
- computer batteries



✗ Unacceptable materials

- appliances
- vacuums
- scrap metal

✗ Not accepted:

commercial waste, tires, reuse materials (clothing, etc.), and scrap metal. If you are unsure whether an item will be accepted at a Special Waste Drop-off Day, contact Halton Region.
