"They will also have a repair shop for skis, boards and bikes. Halton Hills residents have been waiting a long time for this and I think they will all be pleased," said Henderson.

The new wing will also feature a 12,000 sq. ft. Mark's Work Wearhouse that will include a second storey. That store is slated to open in early June.

"Our food court is almost complete. LaVita's Fine Foods opened during the March Break offering a large selection of great food such as pastries, homemade bread and pastas. They also do catering, said Henderson.

Kung Pao Wok (Chinese food) is to open shortly in the Food Court, she added.

Henderson said the renovation project has been in the works for two years and added approximately 20 new stores to the

"To make this happen we had to relocate Walmart, the Food Court, Global Pet, Payless Shoes, Walking on a Cloud, The Source, Ardene (they opened a 10,000 sq. ft. new location next to Walmart) and The Independent Free Press," said Henderson.

The mall's new wing is located in the completely redesigned former Walmart store.

"We cannot forget the existing tenants who have expanded—Brilliant Gold Jewellery, Vanderburgh Flowers, Ardene and The Beer Store. Health @ 280 moved in next door to The Independent Free Press,' she said.
